**OVERVIEW**

A onetime start up scholarship in the amount of \$1500.00 will be awarded for each of thirteen Fredericksburg area high schools. The primary purpose for the scholarship program is to enhance F.O.E visibility within the community and to uphold the Eagles motto; "People Helping People". The scholarships will be awarded to properly nominated students in accordance with the following policies as provided by the AERIE Academic Scholarship Committee and approved by the AERIE membership.

**POLICY**

1. Only one student from each individual school will receive a scholarship.
2. Nominations for a scholarship must come from an Eagle member in good standing. Exceptions are:
  - a. In the event that there are no member submissions for an individual high school listed to receive a scholarship, the high school guidance department for that school will be requested to provide the name of a qualified student who has the most need of the scholarship. It is preferred that the named student not be in receipt of any other scholarship.
  - b. In the event there are multiple nominations for an individual high school, the school guidance department for that school will be consulted to assist in deciding who will receive the award based on financial need and academic performance. The scholarship committee decision will be made at the recommendation of the school guidance department and will be final.
3. Nominations for scholarships must be received no later than the nomination closing date posted in the AERIE social quarters and the AERIE newsletter.
4. The student nominee must be a first year (freshman) student and possess an acceptance letter by the College, University, or Trade School to be eligible for an EAGLE's scholarship.

5. Each scholarship selectee will be announced at a Senior Awards / Scholarship Ceremony held at the respective High Schools. If possible, an Eagle member will represent the Eagles as a presenter at this ceremony. The EAGLE presenter may be from either the AERIE membership or ladies auxiliary.
6. Scholarship funds in the form of a check will be provided directly to the Student **and** the College, University, or Trade School upon presentation by the awardees of their scholarship certificate and acceptance letter to the AERIE secretary.
