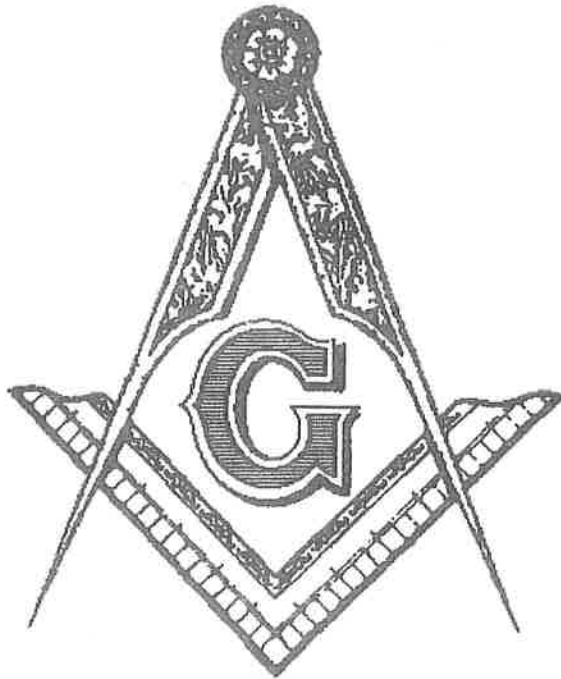

SCHOLASTIC APITUDE TEST (S.A.T.) OR AMERICAN COLLEGE TESTING (ACT)

To be considered for one of the scholarships offered, you must take, or have taken, the Scholastic Aptitude Test (S.A.T.) Your score (original/photocopy) should be sent to the address below along with your application form, transcript, and letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or principal.

The application must be completed and must be received in the Office of the Grand Secretary no later than April 1, 2020.

The application and test scores must be received not later than April 1, 2020. If you send a photocopy, it must have your school's seal and the signature of either a guidance counselor or the principal. If you have not taken the test or received your test scores, the following numbered items will help you.

1. Go to your Counselor or Principal and request an application blank for the S.A.T. OR A.C.T.
2. Fill out the application for the S.A.T. or A.C.T. Check with your Guidance Counselor for the appropriate date(s).
3. Complete all sections of the scholarship application.
4. Enclose with your application an official copy of your high school transcript, and a letter of recommendation from your principal, counselor, or a teacher.
5. Be sure to send your S.A.T. or A.C.T. score.

Under no circumstances will this application be considered if it does not contain all signatures or arrives after April 1, 2020.
