Thank you for your interest in Mary Washington Healthcare's Future Healthcare Providers program. We are excited to make this opportunity available to local high school students again for the 2019-2020 school year.

You will see from the schedule that we have an interesting line-up of topics and presenters to give you an overview of a variety of healthcare careers. The September session will be held in the Tompkins Martin Medical Bldg (1101 Sam Perry Blvd), Classroom A on the ground floor. The remaining sessions will be begin in the MWH Cafeteria (lower level.)

You are not required to attend each session but hope that you will make every effort to attend as many as possible. Regular attendance will give you a broader knowledge of the many careers possible in healthcare.

1. Read the Overview/Parental Consent form and Confidentiality Agreement carefully and discuss the terms with a parent/guardian.
2. Pay close attention to the dress code instructions. Students arriving in jeans, shorts or leggings will not be allowed to tour the hospital. Also remember, closed toed shoes are required for tours as well. Athletic shoes are ideal.
3. Presentations begin promptly at 6:00 pm. Arrive early enough to be in the meeting room prior to the 6:00 pm start.
4. Both you and a parent/guardian must sign the consent form. The Confidentiality Agreement is to be signed by you.
5. You can scan and return the forms prior to the first session to Patricia.Wolfrey@mwhc.com or bring them with you the first night. We MUST have both forms signed and turned in prior to your participation.
6. Photographs and videos are prohibited. Cell phones are to be turned off and kept out of sight throughout the program and tour.
7. Come prepared to ask questions and absorb as much information as possible. We want you to take away knowledge and excitement about a future career in healthcare!
